1. Background

Announcement

Women's choirs from all over the world are invited to meet in Leipzig, the world-class music city, to make music together and to meet each other.

Leipzig is not only the place of work of composers such as Bach, Mendelssohn Bartholdy and Grieg, but also the birthplace and workplace of Clara Schumann. On this occasion, there is an invitation to women in Germany and abroad to come together in Leipzig in the spirit of Clara Schumann.

2. Participation

The festival is open to women's choirs of all styles and sizes. It is not a competition. Participation in all activities is optional and must be confirmed upon application.

3. Program

Friday, 5 June 2025: Reception at the New City Hall

Encounter concerts

Saturday, 6 June 2026: Performances in the city centre of Leipzig - Passagensingen

Barcamp Workshops

Great Joint Concert in the Monument of the Battle of Nations

Sunday, 7 June 2026: Performances in Leipzig churches

4. Workshops

The workshops are conducted according to the bar camp method, which means that the participating choirs themselves decide on the content by presenting methods and pieces of their choral work to each other. Ideally, two choirs organize a workshop together.

5. Organizer:

The Leipzig Choral Association is the umbrella organization of over 80 choirs from Leipzig and the surrounding area. As a service provider of his affiliated choirs, he works voluntarily and without profit interest.
